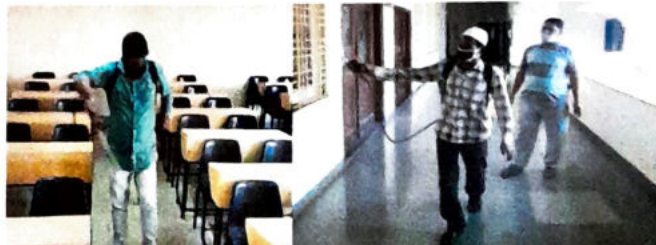

She leaves behind two sons, Arshad Zakaria and Farid Zakaria.
