

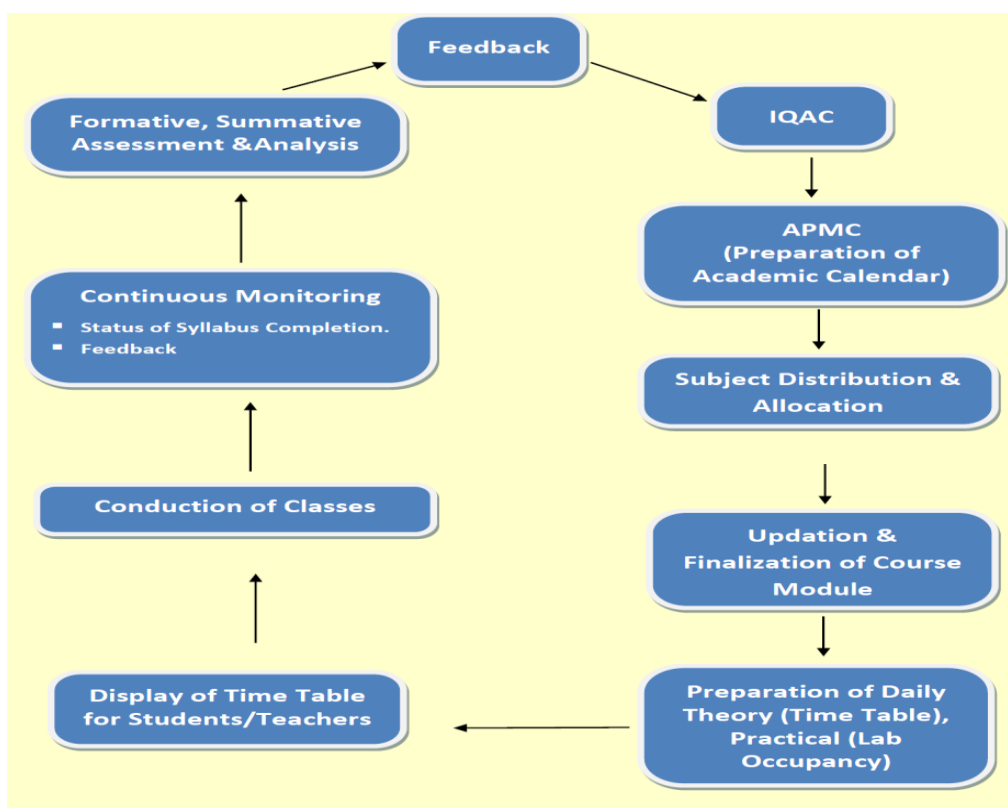
1.1 Curricular Planning and Implementation

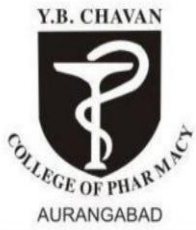


