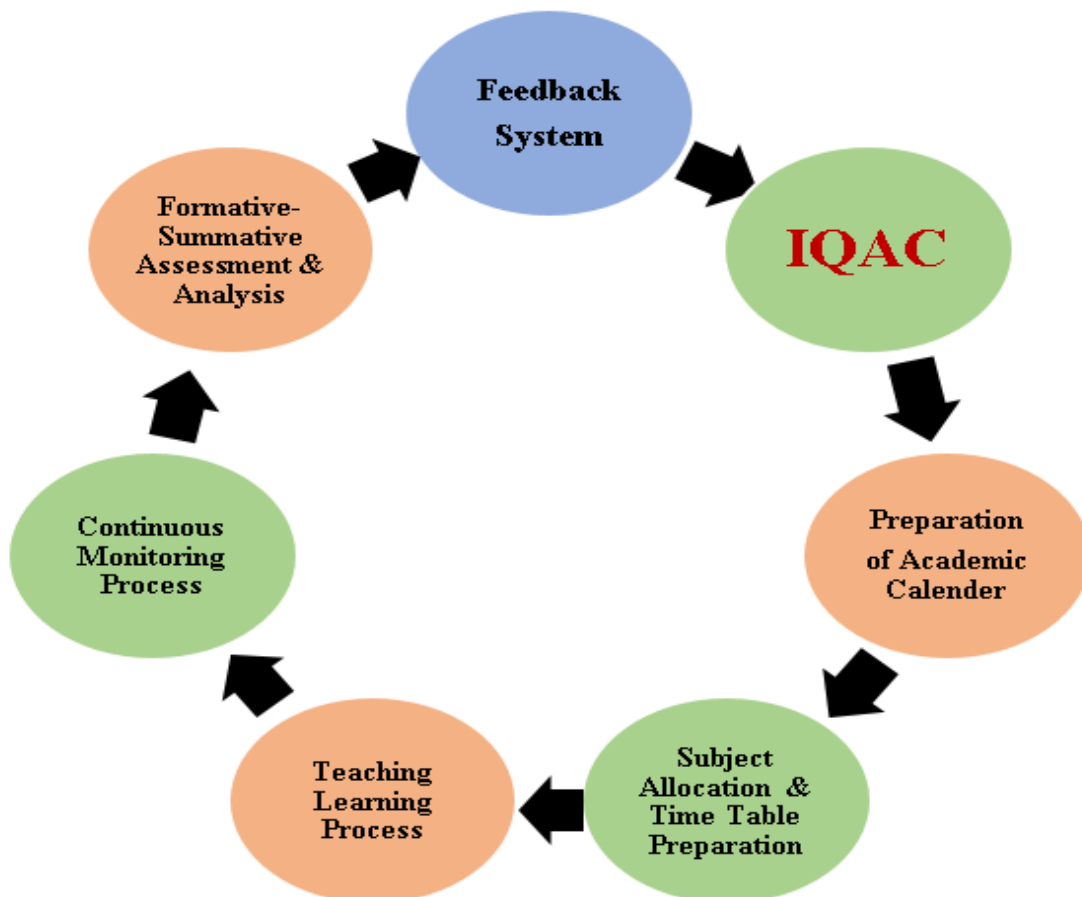

## Activity Report

### Title of Activity: Short Term Training Program on HPLC

1. **Date:** 14<sup>th</sup> September to 18<sup>th</sup> September 2023 (30 Hours)

2. **Venue:** Y. B. Chavan College of pharmacy, Aurangabad.

3. **Outcomes of the activity achieved:**

- Outcome of the STTP is to train specialists who can be effective teachers, Analytical experts and research workers in the specialized field of Analysis.
- STTP is designed to develop in-depth theoretical knowledge with hands-on skills
- STTP is providing practical exposure to the participants to perform Analytical Testing using HPLC competently and confidently.
- STTP is make the participant expertise in the method development and validation of single drug and simultaneous estimation of drug and trouble shooting on HPLC

4. **Description of activity:**

The Y. B. Chavan College of Pharmacy Aurangabad hosted a 30-hour, four-day STTP on High-Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC) from September 14th to 18th, 2023. This program was organized by the Advanced Instrumentation Research (AIR) Facility Laboratory. Dr. J. N. Sangshetti, the Head of the Quality Assurance Department, and Dr. Mohd Sayeed Shaikh, in charge of the AIR Facility Laboratory, coordinated the STTP on HPLC. 11 participants attended the STTP on HPLC, where they received comprehensive

theoretical knowledge and practical skills under the guidance of Dr. J. N. Sangshetti and Dr. Mohd Sayeed Shaikh.

#### **5. Activity Experience:**

The training program focused on providing participants with practical exposure to competently and confidently perform Analytical Testing using HPLC. Specific areas covered included:

- 1) Method Development and Validation: Participants gained expertise in developing and validating methods for single drug analysis.
- 2) Simultaneous Estimation of Drugs: Participants gained expertise Techniques for simultaneously estimating multiple drugs using HPLC were covered, enhancing participants' proficiency in pharmaceutical research and quality control.
- 3) Troubleshooting on HPLC: Participants gained expertise insights into troubleshooting common HPLC issues, enabling participants to identify and resolve challenges effectively.

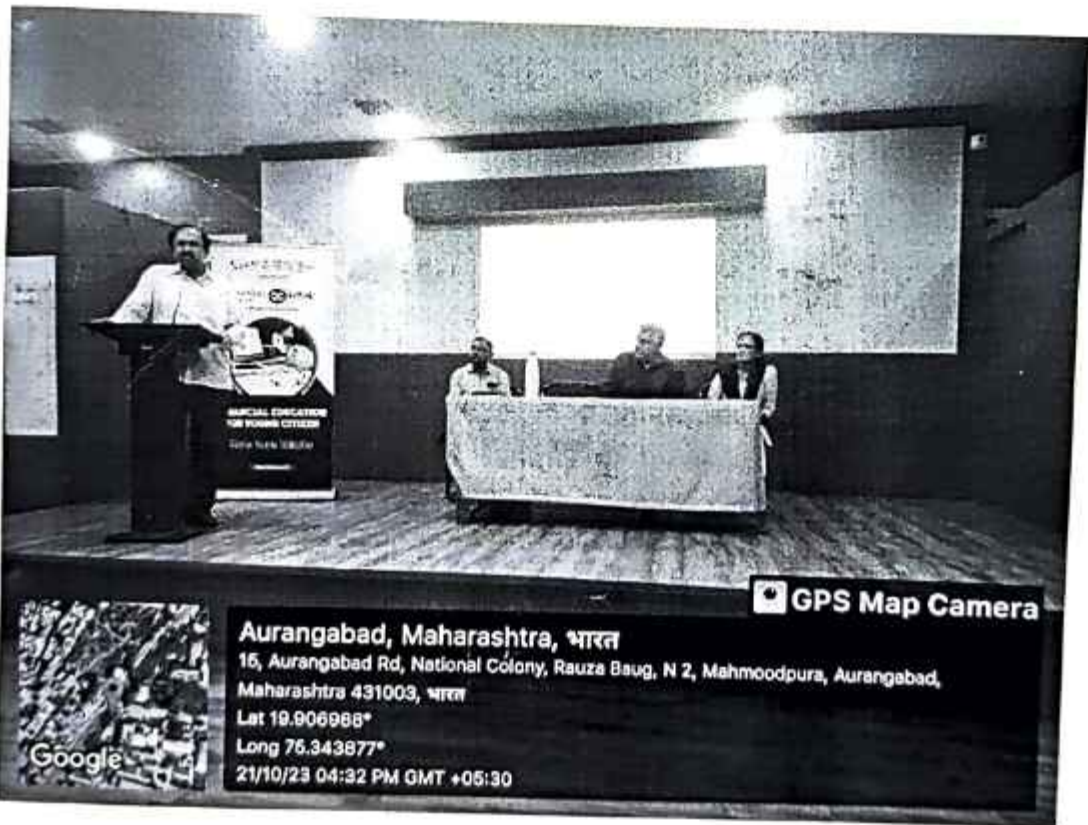
