Following students are appointed as Campus Ambassador for the session 2022-23:



Responsibilities of Campus Ambassadors:


1. To guide students on enrolling in the voter's list.

6. They will help the authorities in organizing the National Voters' Day programme and creating awareness.


7. To instill the values of democracy among young voters.
