Monday National Education Policy 2020

India's new National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 is based on concepts of equity, equality and accessibility, as said by the Union Education Minister, Dr. Smriti Irani. The Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved the new Education Policy which is considered as one of the major decisions taken in the field of education. The Cabinet reviewed the Ministry of Human Resource and Development (MHRD) as the Ministry of Education. According to the Union Cabinet, the major benefit of the NEP 2020 is to provide New Reforms and Rejuvenation of Education in India that will be beneficial to the students of India. The NEP was approved by the Union Cabinet that was formed by a panel of experts led by the former Union Chief Justice of India, Justice R.K. Jaisankar. The NEP had discussed the issues about the changes to be brought about in the Indian Education System - ranging from school to college to vocational. These suggestions were approved by majority.

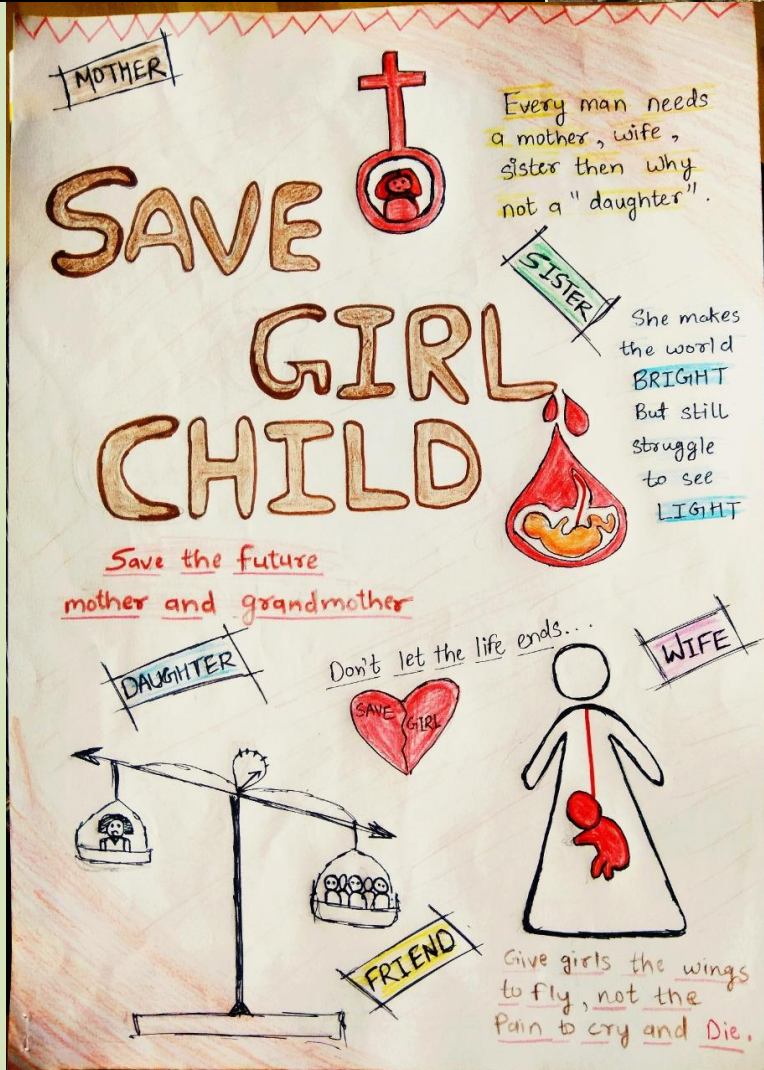
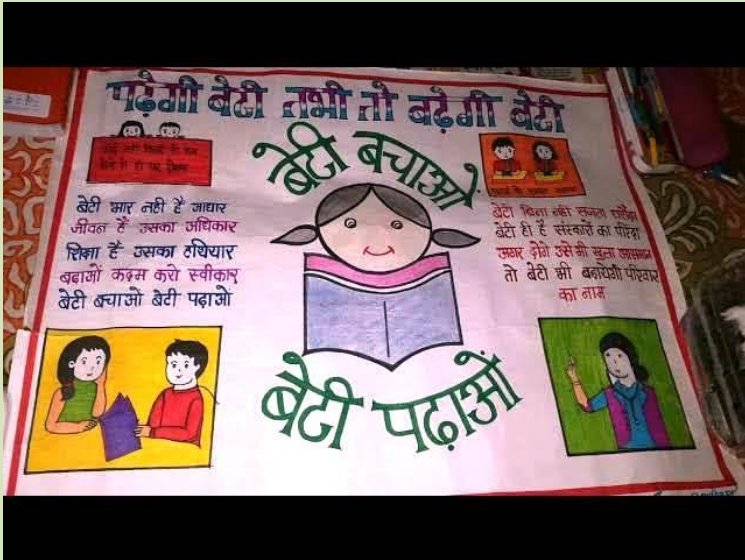

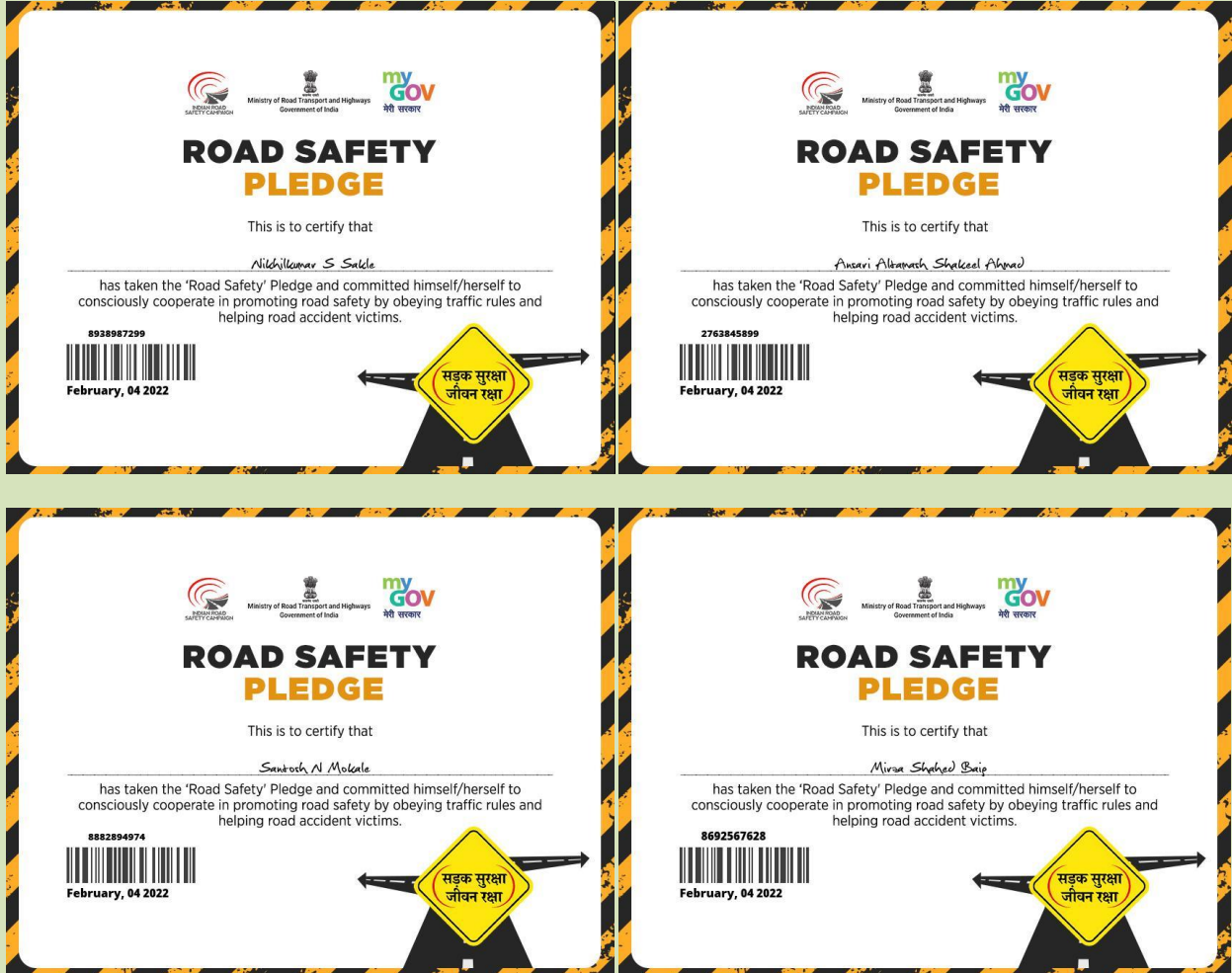

## **08. International Women's Day Celebration**

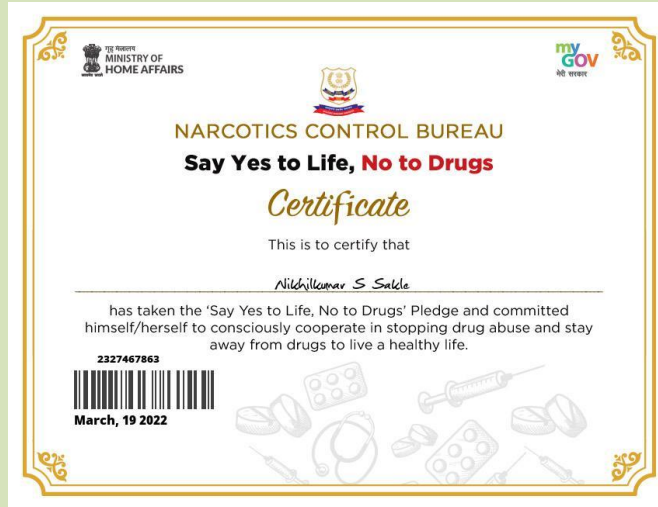
1. **Date and Venue:** Auditorium, Y. B. Chavan College of Pharmacy, Aurangabad, 8/3/2022
