- 6) To regular monitoring of the progress and impact of various initiatives is crucial. SC/ST cells are tasked with collecting data, evaluating programs, and reporting findings to higher authorities.

- 8) Counselling services and Legal assistance is provided to SC/ST members facing discrimination or any difficulties for support mental and emotional well-being.
- 9) SC/ST cells engage with local community experts and BARTI, SARTHI and TRTI to promote education, health, and social welfare. Outreach programs help in building trust and collaboration with the communities they serve.
